Introduction


Explorus Adventure Learning is a private company committed to the empowerment & development of young people through Adventure Learning programs. We began our journey in 1986 when we were known as Merribrook Adventures. Since then we have worked with over 200,000 students and corporate clients throughout Australia, a large number of whom have been with us since our inception.

We now only provide adventure based outdoor programs under contract for schools. We work with groups of 20 to 160 students between Year 6 (~11 years old) and Year 11 (~16 years old). These groups are divided into subgroups of 12-20 students, with one school teacher & two Explorus Group Leaders. Programs range in duration from 4 to 10 days. Our base is at Karridale near Hamelin Bay in the Shire of Augusta Margaret River. We run programs locally in the Leeuwin Naturaliste National Park with students experiencing forests, rivers, caves, sea cliffs and the ocean. We also work in the Blackwood River area, Dwellingup, Byford and the Murchison region of WA. We currently have vacancies for **Group Leaders** who can competently & safely lead a group of students for the duration of their program, and **Skills Instructors** with recognised activity expertise and certification.

Our aims are for students to learn more about *themselves, the people around them & the natural environment.* You will be required to teach & support students during a program that takes them away from their normal routines. Our goal is to foster independence & encourage self-reliance & resilience in sometimes testing conditions through living in a small, functional & cohesive community.

Most programs are journey-based expeditions or have an expedition component.

What we look for in a successful applicant

- o Maturity and a range of life experiences that enhance your ability to assess and judge situations in a changing environment. Experience and maturity also enable you to better relate to and care for all our clients;
- o A personal passion for working with young people in Australian natural environments;
- The ability and desire to work with a range of groups in the outdoors under potentially stressful conditions;
- o An abundance of enthusiasm, initiative and commitment to organisational best practice and to a team that provides quality programs in a professional, fun working environment;
- A strong commitment to facilitating the growth, education and development of others on an individual and community level;
- o Ability to travel comfortably and safely in the outdoors and teach others to do the same;
- o Familiarity with Outdoor Education / Experiential Learning philosophy;
- o A personal passion and pursuit of outdoor adventure based activities in your own time; and
- o A responsible and developed environmental ethos & commitment to sustainable practices.

Adventure Learning Leaders

You are the people who create the experience the students on our programs have. You are also responsible for the experience you have with your fellow workers. At Explorus we recognise the differing range of skills and experience people bring with them. However we encourage a Co-Leading arrangement between the two Adventure Learning Leaders with each group. At times there will be an obvious difference in skills & experience in your pairings, and other times you will be fairly equally matched.

Those with a high degree of skill & experience in a particular area, for example – rock climbing or canoeing – may also have the opportunity to work as a Skills Instructor if currently certified.

Individuals applying for a position as an Adventure Learning Leader are expected to have *prior experience* in this role. A large part of being a successful leader is being able to draw on your experience to make sometimes-difficult judgement calls with regard to the well being of the group. Advanced facilitation of the group experience is another important skill a good leader must have to ensure that it is *more than just an activity based experience* and to assist with the transfer of the students experience back into their life at home. These two final points only come with experience both in your personal ventures and through working with groups in a variety of conditions. A responsible and developed environmental ethos & commitment to sustainable practices is highly desirable.

We also require an advanced level of "soft" and technical skill development for Experienced Leaders & Skills Instructors.

Essential For All Positions

- o A personal passion for working with people in Australian natural environments:
- The ability and desire to work with a range of groups in the outdoors under potentially stressful conditions;
- o Familiarity with Outdoor Education / Experiential Learning philosophy;
- Logged experience in teaching some or all of: bushwalking, camping, camp cooking, navigation, expedition travel, high ropes courses, canoeing, rock climbing, abseiling and caving;
- Prior recognised roping training and / or experience to be able to competently complete our annual Abseiling Belay Assessment – *if not*, you must agree to attend roping training run by Explorus in February 2018, which will be unpaid.
- o Current Remote Area First Aid qualification as a *minimum* (SISOOPS305A)
- Current W.A Working With Children Clearance (we will assist in this process if you are a successful applicant and don't have a WA Clearance)
- o A National Police Clearance less than 3 years old
- o Current Driver's Licence (manual car licence minimum); and
- The ability to give and receive constructive feedback for personal growth.

Experienced Leaders

- A high degree of group facilitation experience;
- The ability to apply risk management processes and manage student groups in remote settings; and
- Recognised competency in at least two of the following areas: bushwalking, caving, roping or canoeing.

Leaders

 Prior experience in teaching bushwalking and camping skills, roping, canoeing and a desire to develop these skills further.

Skills Instructors

- o **Recognised competency** in at least two of the following areas: high ropes course, caving, rock climbing, abseiling or canoeing (preferably canoeing and one other);
- Extensive experience in managing a site and a group for a skills activity; and
- The ability to apply risk management processes, including emergency responses, and manage students in remote settings.

We are seeking staff with more than just hard skills – they can be learnt. If you are articulate, able to communicate effectively and have received a broad education in a traditional and non-traditional sense, your Application will be stronger.
